#### THE PERSEVERA SCHOLARSHIPS

The School Perseverance Committee has decided to increase the financial contribution so that a new cohort of young people can benefit from the school perseverance scholarships.

In 2015-2016, we will be providing support for an additional 20 young people, bringing the total to forty, 20 each in the third and fourth years of high school.
